# Visa

### KENYA VISA

Nationals of most countries require a Visa to enter Kenya and these may be obtained either at your nearest Kenyan Embassy or High Commission, or increasingly the Kenyan E-Visa may be processed on line. The E-Visa system is the simplest way to apply, pay and receive a visa within approximately 2 working days. The E-Visa printout must be presented on arrival at the port of entry.

### REQUIRED DOCUMENTS ON ARRIVAL

1. Passport with at least one empty page and with at least 6 months validity from arrival date
2. Printed E-Visa
3. Return Ticket
4. For Business Travellers, letter of invitation from host company and a copy of that company's registration (please tick the respective box on the registration form)
5. Hotel Details
6. Yellow Fever Vaccination Certificate (not older than 10 years)
